Anniversary of Storm Eunice

Storm Eunice struck on 18th February 2022 and a new record for the fastest wind gust was recorded in England with 122 miles per hour (196 km/h) at The Needles, Isle of Wight. The storm was the most powerful to impact the south coast of England since the Great Storm of 1987.

Sadly, there were several casualties, including three fatalities. Eunice caused at least £360 million worth of damage in the UK
