



When George's guardian angel pays him a visit, he is amazed to discover what life in his beloved town would be like without him. Maybe it's a wonderful life after all?

Written as a 4 hander, the play has scope for more actors. Facilities up-date

Portable Appliance Testing (PAT) was completed a few months ago. It is generally done annually, and this was a very BIG job.

What the heck is PAT anyway?

PAT is a periodic check of any portable (usually plug in) electrical device, with a simple visual check and a check with a simple testing device. It is very easy to do, and we are looking for people who would like to learn how to do it.

So...

Would you like to learn to Portable Appliance Test (PAT) at the Theatre?

If you are methodical, sensible, and have a basic understanding of the use of electrical devices and the ability to learn a new skill, then we would ask you to complete a short online training course with a test (certification) which can be completed in a day. It is a very easy task, and you will obtain a certificate to confirm that you have this excellent transferable skill.

SPT will pay for your test certification and an experienced person will support you on your first few tests.
