#### Job Descriptions:

#### List of easy cleaning type jobs:

• Unblocking and clearing Hoovers before they are put to the task of cleaning the theatre otherwise they won't work!

#### **Auditorium requires**

- Auditorium seating needs checking for damage and cleaning polishing etc

Any time given freely is greatly appreciated especially by the building itself. It is getting old and needs our love and care to be able to continue.

#### For the more adventurous types:

(A bit of experience required or just a willingness to learn)

- Empty furniture store
- Check furniture for damage
- Vacuum and steam clean sofas and chairs

- May need assistance from crew regarding damaged furniture

- Hang and secure cleaned backdrops on rollers and size crew supervision needed
- Steam clean stage curtains
- Weeding in car park & trim trees
- Clean & paint outside benches in garden

- Clear guttering of leaves and debris round the Theatre
